Station suspects it is manuel Antonio STRASBURGER since Hybrap-1
recently told the Station that Raimundo QUIDIELLO Castillo
(local J.U.R.E. representative) had informed Hybrap-1 that he
was being blackmailed by STRASBURGER, a former business partner.

STRASBURGER threatened QUIDIELLO with a disclosure of his personal
letters which would embarase QUIDIELLO, ODYOKE, and KUBARK.

Apparently QUIDIELLO did not yield to the threat hence the
letter to the Ambassador and at least one other copy which

BURGG-1 showed to (HYGIRD-1 on 15 December.
