Proposed attacks by exile leaders

Armaldo S.Haurkat, a loader of the Venezuelan branch of the Outen exile Popular Revolutionary Hovement (M.R.P.), elaised on 16th key that M.R.P., ALPRA 68 and Second &SCAMBRAY Fromb have joined forces to promote attacks against Soviet targets in Oute.

2. A Outen exile ship with a complement of 15 to 90 man is now as sea for this purpose.

- 3. This operation is to be the first of a series of raids by ALPHA 66 and Second &SCAMBRAY Pront under the command of aloy GUTIARR& Menoyo.
- 4. Exile strength consists of this ship and 2 launches operated from three unidentified Caribbean bases and supplied from a similar main base called "Base &SPARANZA". All these are outside the United States. The Exiles also hope to replace 2 other launches which have been seized by the United States.
