Proposed attacks by exile leaders

Arnaldo S. HERRERA, a leader of the Venezuelan branch of the Cuban exile Popular Revolutionary Movement (M.R.P.), advised on 16th May that M.R.P., ALPHA 66 and Second ESCAMBRAY Front have joined forces to promote attacks against Soviet targets in Cuba.

2. A Cuban exile ship with a complement of 15 to 20 men is now at sea for this purpose.

3. This operation is to be the first of a series of raids by ALPHA 66 and Second ESCAMBRAY Front under the command of Eloy GUTIERREZ Menoyo.

4. Exile strength consists of this ship and 2 launches operated from three unidentified Caribbean bases and supplied from a similar main base called "Base ESPERANZA". All these are outside the United States. The Exiles also hope to replace 2 other launches which have been seized by the United States.
