

Richard E. SNYDER (born 10 Dec. 1919, Passaic, N.J.)

1. You advised me that Robert KENNEDY of OP had called you, asking about Subject's file (apparently he retired as a Foreign Service Officer (20 years, age 50) on 30 April 1970; he would like to do some work, on project or parttime basis). You asked if I knew of any reason why Mr. BURNES had requested flagging of OP file "to be sure inquiries would be referred to OD/Pers for further check with RI files".

Subject is the subject of CS file 201-748009, re-2. stricted to CI/R&A (Paul HARTMAN). From the file it is noted that Subject worked for CIA 27 Mar. '50-26 Sept. '50, resigning for personal reasons. The file was restricted because of involvement with Lee Harvey OSWALD, assassin of the late President John Kennedy. While Subject was 2nd Secretary at the US Embassy in Moscow, on 31 Oct. 1959, he interviewed Lee Harvey OSWALD, when OSWALD appeared at the US Embassy, stating that he wished to renounce his US citizenship and become a citizen of the USSR. (My review shows nothing reflecting adversely on Subject in connection with that episode). An article in the 28 Feb. 1964 edition of the Northern Virginia Sun, written by Robert S. ALLEN and and Paul SCOTT, alleged that "State Department records show that OSWALD had several meetings with the CIA representative in the U.S. Embassy in Moscow. ... One State Department cable, No. 234, dated Nov. 2, 1959, reports that OSWALD was interviewed by the CIA and other embassy officials." In a memorandum dated 18 March 1964, addressed to Mr. J. Lee RANKIN, subject "Article Alleging that OSWALD Was Interviewed by CIA in Moscow", Mr. Richard Helms, then Deputy Director for Plans, commented on the allegation as follows: "I desire to state for the record that the allegation carried in this press report is utterly unfounded as far as CIA is concerned." 3. The 201 file reflects that Subject's contacts, in university circles, included (201-012574), born ca. 1926 in Peland, who is married to the daughter of famous Czech leader. If you wish to return to the United States for personal reasons during that period, all travel and transportation costs incident to-such return will be borne by you, with no expense to the Government.

4. If this omployment is for assignment to an overseas post, it is understood and agreed that, unless earlier separated for reasons beyond your control, you will remain in Government service for 12 months after your arrival at your first overseas post, and if you violate this agreement, any money expended by the United States on account of your travel and the transportation of your immediate family and household goods will be considered a debt due to the United States.

5. Employment is conditioned upon satisfactory completion of the training courses prescribed by CIA and satisfactory performance of duty for a total period of six months from date of employment. In the event

either training or performance of duty is deemed unsatisfactory by CIA, you will be offered other types of employment if available, or your employment will be terminated.

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SECRECY AGREEMENT

1. I. <u>Hence D. Farework</u>, understand that by virtue of my duties in the <u>CIA</u> I may be the recipient of information and intelligence which concerns the present and future security of the United States and which belongs to the United States. This information and intelligence, together with the methods of collecting and handling it, are classified according to standards set in the State, Mar, and Navy Departments. I have read and understand the provisions of the Act of Congress of June 15, 1917 (Espionage Act), as amended, concerning the disclosure of information relating to the National Defense and I an familiar with the penaltics provided for viciation thereof.

2. I agree that I do not now, hor shall I ever possess any right, interest, title or claim in or to any of the information or intelligence or the methods of collecting or handling of it which has come or shall come to my attention by virtue of my connection with the (2/2), but shall always recognize the property right of the United States of America in and to such matters.

3. I do solemnly swear that I will never divulge, publish nor reveal either by word, conduct, or by any other means such classified information, intelligence or knowledge, except in the performance of my official duties and in accordance with the laws of the United States, unless specifically authorized in writing in cuch case by the ℓ/ρ .

4. I understand that no change in my assignment or employment will relieve me of my obligation under this oath and that the provisions of this oath will remain binding upon me even after the termination of my services with the United States.

5. I understand that my employment by the <u>C/A</u> is conditioned upon my understanding of and strict compliance with "Security Regulations , " and the appendices therete.

6. I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion.

ESPIONAGE

Unlawfully obtaining or permitting to be obtained information ٦. affecting national defense. - That (a) Wheever, for the purpose of obtaining information respecting the national defense with intent or reason to believe that the information to be obtained is to be used to the injury of the United States, or to the advantage of any fereign nation, goes upon, enters, flies over, or otherwise obtains information concerning any vessel, aircraft, work of defense, nevy yard, naval station, submarine base, coaling station, fort, battery, torpedo station . dochyard, canal, railroad, arsenal, camp, fectory, minc, telegraph, telephone, wireless, or signal station, building, office, or other place connected with the national defense, owned or constructed, or in progross of construction by the United States or under the control of the United States, or of any of its officers or agents, or within the exclusive jurisdiction of the United States, or any place in which any vessol, aircreft, arms, munitions, or other materials or instruments for use in time of war are being made, prepared, repaired, or stored, under any contract or agreement with the United States, or with any person on behalf of the United States, or otherwise on behalf of the United States, or any prohibited place within the meaning of section 6 of this title; or (b) whenever for the purpose aforesaid, and with like intent or reason to believe, copies, takes, makes, or obtains, or attempts, or induces or aids another to copy, take, make, or obtain, any sketch, photograph, photographic negative, blueprint, plan, mop, model, instrument, appliance, document, writing, or note of enything connected with the national defense; or (c) whoever, for the purpose aforesaid, receives or obtains or agrees or attempts or induces or aids another to receive or obtain from any person, or from any source unatover, any document, writing, cyle book, signal book, sketch, photo work, plotographic negative, blueprint, plen, map, model, instrument, appliance, or note, of anything connected with the national defense, moving or having reason to believe, at the time he receives or obtains, or agrees or attempts or induces or aids another to receive or obtain it, that it has been or will be obtained, taken, made or disposed of by any person contrary to the provisions of this title; or (d) wheever, lawfully or unlawfully having possession of, access to, centrol over, or being intrusted with any document, writing, code book, signal, took, skotch, photograph, photographic negative, blueprint, plan, map, zodol, instrument, appliance, or note relating to the national defense, villfully communicates or transmits or attempts to communicate or transmit the same to any person not entitled to receive it, or willfully retains the same end fails to deliver it on demand to the officer or employee of the United States entitled to receive it; or (s) wheever, being intrusted with or having lawful possession or control of any document, writing, code book, signel book, sketch, photographic acgative, blueprint, plan, may, model, note, or information, relating to the national defense, through gross negligence permits the same to be removed from its proper place of custody or delivered to enpone in violation of his trust, or to be losi, stolen, abstracted, or destroyed, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than ten years and may, (21-8)

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in the discretion of the court, be fined not more than \$10,000. (See. 1, Title I, act 15 June 1917 (40 Stat. 217), as amended by sec. 1, act 28 March 1940 (54 Stat. 79; 50 U.S.G. 31)).


2. Unlawfully disclosing information effecting national defense.-(a) Whoever, with intent or reason to believe that it is to be used to the injury of the United States or to the advantage of a foreign nation, communicator, dolivers, or transmits, or attempts to, er aids or induces another to, communicate, deliver, or transmit, to any foreign government, or to any faction or party or military or naval force within a foroign country, whether recognized or unrecognized by the United States, or to any representative, officer, agent, employee, subject, or citizen thereof, either directly or indirectly, may document, writing, code book, signal book, skotch, photograph, photographic negative, blueprint, plan, mop, model, note, instrument, appliance, or information relating to the national defense, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than twenty years: Provided, That whoever shall violate the provisions of subacction (a) of this section in time of war shall be punished by death or by imprimonment for not more than thirty years; and (b) wheever, in time of war, with intent that the sense shall be communicated to the energy. shall collect, record, publish, or communicate, or attempt to elicit any information with respect to the movement, numbers, description, condition. or disposition of any of the armed forces, ships, aircraft, or war materials of the United States, or with respect to the plans or conduct, or supposed plans or conduct of any neval or military operations, or with respect to any works or mensures undertaken for or connected with, or intended for the fortification or defense of any place, or any other information relating to the public defense, which night be useful to the energy, shall be punished by death or by imprisonment for not more than thirty years.
