1. Meference is made to your file number (S) 105-77772, subject: Marvin KANTUR and to your file number (S) 103-62555, subject: Les Marvey OSVALD.

2. It may be of interest to your office to note the following coincidences in the backgrounds of KANTOR and Los Hervey and Marioe CSWALD:

- a. As you know from previous correspondence regarding MATOR, he reportedly was in Minsk, USSR, for six works during the summer of 1958 and during the period 2 June to 8 Suptamber 1959. Although OSWALD apparently did not arrive in Minsk sutil January 1960. Marine GSWALD, according to her own testimosy, arrived in Minsk toward the end of August 1959.
- b. In interviews on 3 and 4 May 1961, in Copanhagen, Demmark, with an employee of this Agency who was known to XANTOR as "a representative of American Intelligence", KABTOR claimed to have been something of an addity in Minsk mince he was the only American residing there at the time. As such, he claimed to have attracted to himself a group of young Saviets who displayed an unusual curiosity about the standard of living in the United Status and Mastern Europa and where interasts centered around girls, cars, having a good time and listening to jazz music on the Voice of America. Among thuse young Soviets, according to SANTOR, was a young an unusual Igor (LNU), "whose father was a Suviet army general". It is interasting that OSMALD also reportedly

considered bimself to be an oddity as the only American residing in Minsk and attracted more or less the same type young Soviets as did KANTOR. It should be noted that OSWALD listed among his close friends in Minsk a young Soviet named Pavel GOLOVACHEV, whose father ostansibly was a Soviet army general.

c. Both KANTOR and OSWALD had served as enlisted was and technicians in the United States Harine Corps.

d. According to a report from your Detroit office, dated 14 August 1964, KANTOR is apployed by the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Hichigan, as a lecturer in Slavic languages and literature in the university's College of Literature, Science and Arts. According to press reports, Marina OSWALD is currently enrolled in a special English language course at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan.
