More on Oswald Case

F ORMERLY classified transcripts of Warren Commission sessions disclosed that Lee Harvey Osaald was such an "extremely poor shot" dureig his stay in Russia in 1959 that honting companions had to give him game. The Commission received this data from Yuri Ivanovich Nosenko, a Russian secret police agent who defected to the U.S. three months after the assassination of President Kennedy, according to an article by Pavid Wise in the current issue of the Saturday Evening Post. The same article said the Commission tried but failed to see vital autopsy photographs to ciarrify "confusing" evidence about the builets which struck the President.
