- 3. IN JANUARY 1964, RUSSIAN OIL-DRILLING CREWS STRUCK OIL ON CAYO FRANCES; THE STRIKE IS PRODUCING 300 BARRELS A DAY. 6. IN THE RECENT ATTACK AT SIGUANEA, ISLA DE PINOS, THE CUBAN GUARDS DID NOT FIRE ON THE ATTACKERS BECAUSE THEY WERE AFRAID THEIR SHOTS MIGHT SET OFF EXPLOSIVE CHARGES UNDER THE ROCKETS. THE PORT OF CABAÑAS, ALTHOUGH REINFORCED SINCE RECENT ATTACKS, WOULD BE AN EASIER TARGET FOR A RAID THAN THE ISLA DE PINOS AREA.
