- 1. Enference is made to Bureau report (DBA-22356, New York Office) pertaining to Subject and dated 24 September 1902. This report contained information to the effect that Subject had left the United States for a visit to Algeria and would be working there as a journalist for several Borth American and European nevapapers.
- 2. In early December 1962 our representative in Algiers forwarded a clipping from the 2-3 December issue of the Front Liberation Estimale (FLE) newspaper. Al Chast, which contained an article on Subject. A copy of this article is attached for the Bureau's information.
- 3. Further, our representative reported the following information on Subject which had been received from a reliable Agency source. Sometime is the past when Subject resided in New York City, he attempted to establish a Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FRCC) for Algeria. The reliable Agency source, who had shown an embryosic interest in joining the FFCC for Algeria, approached Abdelkader CHANDERLI, Permanent Representative of Algeria to the United Rations, and naked CHANDERLI what he thought of Subject. CHANDERLI told Source that Subject was not sessone Source should get close to and commented that bublect is paid by the Cubans.
- 4. Any further information concerning the above Subject which pay come to the attention of this Agency will be promptly forwarded to the Bureau.
