- 3. At the time of termination, LICOCKY-1 was given (1) salary for February 1966, (2) one-way airfare from Mexico City to New York, and (3) Federal Tax refund amounting to 9,005.00 NN. The household items in her possession at the time of termination, which belonged to the Station, were sold to her for US \$300.00.
- 4. It should be noted that although LICOOKY-I claims she intends to remain in the United States, she retained her apartment, which was turned over to a rental agency for sub-renting. The Station believes that she intends to return within the next several months or so should it develop that she cannot find suitable work in the New York area. Should she do so on her own it may be that the Station would want to make occasional use of her, and for that purpose a post office box to which she can write to initiate contact was given her prior to departure.

- 1. LICOOKY-1 has been terminated effective 1 July 1966.

 The last meeting with her was held on 23 June. She was paid her salary through 30 June, her income tax refund for the period 1 January 1965 30 June 1966 and given money for one-way air fare to New York City. She was completely matisfied with the financial terms of the settlement. A Termination Secrecy Oath, signed in true name, was obtained.
- 2. L-1 plans to return to New York on or about 1 July. She said she will look for a job there, and is confident she will have no difficulty obtaining one. She does not yet know where she will be living.
- 3. L-I is subletting the apartment she occupies here. She has purchased the KUBARK-owned household effects which has en lead to her for that apartment. For this reason, in eldition to the fact that she has acquired many close falores and interests here as a result of five years residence, the Station expects that she will return to Mexico. I would she insists she has no plans to do so.

New York KUBARK office is listed in the directory and she could call that office if contact were necessary while she was in the United States. She asked if that would still be the case and was told that it was but only to attempt such contact for an important or urgent matter. But since she tends to liberally apply importance to a wide variety of events and subjects, and since she is likely to be short of money shortly after arriving, it would not be surprising if she did try to establish such contact.

- 1. The first steps to organize the Mexican Writers' Association (AEM Asociación de Escritores de México) were taken in February of 1964 after Bartolome Costa-AEIC and the Zaplana Bookstores published a proposal in the metropolitan newspapers, offering to establish a new series of library prizes and urging the Mexican writers to join an association that could provide material benefits for its members. The first meeting of the AEM was held on 11 August 1964. For some time the AEM remained as insignificant as other similar organizations which had been organized from time to time, such as the Society of Literary Authors and The Society of Friends of Mexican Books which never achieved any effectiveness or respectability. Mexico's established and well known writers have always shunned these organizations.
- 2. LICCOKY-1 became interested in the AEM through her friendship with Costa-Amic and saw the possibility of building the AEM into an organization which would include the middle of the road and right wing authors who had been systematically boycotted since the Lázaro Cárdenas' regime when Narciso Bassols, a member of the Communist Party, was Minister of Education.
- 3. LICCOKY-1 began a one man campaign of recruiting relatively well known right wing writers who could not be considered medicare or nonentities. As LICCOKY-1's campaign began to succeed it became easier to recruit the more important writers of Mexico covering the whole political spectrum. In October of 1964, LICCOKY-1

persuaded Carlos Pellicer Canara, well known Mexican poet, to
join the AEM. It then became easier to get other well known
writers to join. In all LICCCKY-1 recruited about 80 of the well
known Mexican writers to come into the AEM. At this time LICCCKY1 knew nothing of the European Community of Writers (COMES - Soviet to accommunity Communité Europea degli Scrittori) or plans to form a Community with,
of Latin American Writers (CLE - Comunidad Latinoamericana de
Escritores).

- 4. LICCOKY-1 has been appointed to the Board of Directors of the ADM which permits LICCOKY-1 to attend all Board Meetings and she is relied upon to do all details of organization and planning the ADM projects to assist the Mexican writer which is the ultimate objective of the ADM.
- 5. In this work LICOCKY-1 has developed friendships with the leaders of the AEM including Fellicer and Juan Rulfo, both of whom were Mexican delegates to the CCHES Conference held in Geneva, Switzerland during the winter of 1935. Fellicer has invited LICOCKY=1 to his home and confers with her on AEM problems, usually once a week. She has free entrance to Rulfo's office at the Instituto Indigenista and he has visited LICOCKY-1's apartment.
- 6. The Station hopes that through LICCOKY-1 the AEM can be used to defeat any attempts by COMES through its affiliate CLE to form

a Unity of Writers (UE - Unidad de Escritores) in Ferrieo as well as sabotage the CLE Congress to be held in Mexico in 1963.

- 7. To this end, one of L1000XY-1's principal objectives is to solidify her acceptance in the AZM and she has been given the immediate tasks of:
 - a. Preparing complete assessments and personality data on all of the influential AEM leaders.
 - b. Determining LICOCKY-1's influence on them as a basis for;
 - c. Using the AEM, when the time comes, to keep Fellicer and Rulfo from forming the UE affiliate in Mexico, preparatory to the coming CLE Congress.
 - d. LICCORY-1 is to continue her work in the ARM and to try to become a close confident of Pollicer, Rulfo and other influential leaders of the ARM.
- 8. The Station plans to closely watch the development of the AEM and the plans and activities of Pellicer, Rulfo, Derjamin Carrión, Miguel Angel Asturias and others who may participate in planning for the forthcoming CLE Congress.
