<p>1. An MDT subsectioned [redacted] reported on 12 December 1961 that he had that day, by chance, met General E. GUEVARA, a former colleague of Dr. Auroliano Sandoz, manager, at the New Orleans Airport. 2d/2 P 7303</p> <p>2. [redacted] stated that GUEVARA said that he was returning that day from a trip to Panama and Guatemala. In Panama he had talked to President CIAHOL and had found him to be unpredictable, but, to the contrary, when he had talked to President YDROGOAS in Guatemala he had found him extremely anxious to have CASTRO liquidated. YDROGOAS had asked GUEVARA about his visit to CHIAPAS, and when GUEVARA expressed his opinion, YDROGOAS said it was logical because CHIAPAS was extremely cowardly.</p> <p>3. According to [redacted] GUEVARA further said that a short time ago he had been called by Mr. Bob Hurwitz, Chief of the Cuban Desk in the State Department, and that Hurwitz had told him not to fool around with SANCHEZ or Julio GARNIER because the man who had the support of the U.S. was KHAD-1, and that as he, Hurwitz, had knowledge of the great work done by GUEVARA, he did not want him to continue losing more time.</p> <p>4. [redacted] added that GUEVARA said that a few days later he received a phone call from KHAD-1. GUEVARA told KHAD-1 that he will help KHAD-1, because it was requested, but he would never have done so by his own wish.</p> <p>5. [redacted] said that GUEVARA continued his travel on to Washington, where he resides at 1119 - 27th Street, N.W., Washington 7.</p>
