1. On one occasion, exact date unrecalled, the Chinese Communist Embassy in liabana sent the PURE a letter which it wished delivered to the Salvador Communist Party in time for a Central American Communist Party Congress either going on or about to start. The letter was sent by PURE to the DGI (Cuban Intelligence service) for delivery. When AMRUG/1 said he had no courier going out to Mexico for several days, he was ordered categorically to send a courier specially to Mexico with the letter as soon as possible. He did.

2. No Chinese Communist ever came to the DGI headquarters or offices, but on one occasion when the Chinese Communist Party wished to send funds to Guatemaia for YON Sosa of Caso Asiatico, Alamugai and "NOEL" (Cuban Intelligence officer) were sent to the Chinese Communist Embassy to pick up US\$ 10,000 for delivery to YON. Why the Chinese were given YON the money, Alamugai did not know. This incident and the dispatch of the special courier were the only such cases of which AMMUGAI knew in his DGI experience.
