- L. Arms and ammunition from Cuba are usually transported by launch and transferred at sea in waters close to Cuba. The arms and ammunition were loaded on a Cuban boat (once a naval launch and once a fishing boat) and transferred at sea to a Dominican vessel. (Source would know name of vessel if a list of Doninican vessels were exhibited to mim. )
- 2. The Dondnican vessel used signal lights to announce its location. The Cuban vessel answered also by using lights. The vessels then approached to effect the arms transfer.
- 3. The transfer of arms which was to take place between the 15th and 25th of October 1153 was aborted because of a storm. However, a transfer was made in January 1704. Source stated that he does not have any other information on arms suipment.
- 4. Source said that the Cucan Government usually supplies the money for the procurement of the arms and ammunition Instead of supplying the arms directly to the subversives.
