Subject initially case to the attention of this Office in June 1964 when he replied to an airertisement placed by this Office in a NYC newspaper (utilizing a cover mechanism) for a position as a Russian language linguist. He was interviewed by a representative of this Office, who used the alias of [Faul Peter] and Department of Defense cover, in Philadelphia on 3 September 1964.
- 3. In accordance with our discussions with Mr. Cregar of your sureau, we are attaching herewith the information which was received from Subject concerning his background as well as the report of the debriefing which was accomplished of him on 3 September 1964.
- 4. This Office has no further operational interest in Subject who is being so zivised.
- 5. The attached information is being forwarded to your Lureau for your information because of Subject's current presence in the USA and because of what appears to be an unusual, even suspicious, story concerning his background and the true circumstances of his arrival in the USA.
