As a result of the Warren Commission proceedings, (Liaison) (and the rest of the world) know that JKLANCE has photographic coverage of the Cuban Mission. However, to the best of our knowledge, no one knows where it is or who does it. This is confirmed by (KDAFGHAN) photos showing Cubans, and others, shaking their fists at a house which is not the (KDAFGHAN) site. In our request to (Liaison) to remove the offending traffic sign, Headquarters may be assured that we did not tell (Liaison) the true reason for our request. They were told that it sometimes interfered with physical surveillance. (Liaison) in turn gave the same request to the appropriate contact in the traffic police, using the explanation that their surveillance team wanted the sign removed.
