- 1. Reference is made to your letter dated 2 February 1961, your Pile No. 105-95357, subject as above,
- 2. The information set forth below relative to plans for the formation of a Cuban government in exile is for your confidential information and should receive no further dissemination outside your Burceu.

Negotiations are currently taking place between Manuel Antonio de VARONA of the Prente Revolucionario Democratico (FRD) and Manuel RAY of the Movimier o Revolucionario del Pueblo (MY) for the purpose of establishing a Revolutionary Council which would be representative of a broad stratum of Ouben political, economic and social thinking. RAY and VARONA have formed an organizing committee which is composed of the following individuals: RAY; VARONA; Justo CARILLO Harmandaz; Hismuol ARTIME de Buesa; Felips FAZOS Roome; and Raul CHIRAS.

- 4. The committee has drafted a tentative platform for the forthcoming Revolutionary Council and has additionally prepared a alote of six candidates, one of whom will be selected as Chairman of the Council. These individuals are Jos- MIRO Cardona; VARONA; CARILLO; Carlos HEVIA; NA PAZOS; and Emilio NENERDEL y Renences.
- 5. After the list of six candidates has been circulated in Guba and among Cuban exiles, it is anticipated that the organizing cosmittee will vote on the adoption of the platform, the establishment of the Revolutionary Council and on the chairmanship of the latter. In the interim, it is possible that the organizing coumittee may have been enlarged by the addition of Aureliano SANGIEZ Arrango and Josep FERNAHORZ Hernandag.
- 6. Any additional data pertaining to the above untter which comes to the attention of this Agency will be forwarded promptly to the Bureau.
