ANTI-FREI, CASTRO ACTIVITIES
IN U.S.A., FACILITY - CUBA

On January 8, 1963, a confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he had learned that Jose Kiro Cardosa, Head of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, an anti-social organization, was in Washington, D. C., and desired to see [redacted]

The informant later learned that [redacted] had contacted Cardosa and had advised him that Juan Bosch, Presidential elect of the Dominican Republic, is "taking the same line we have." [redacted] and Cardosa, according to the informant, agreed to a further discussion to take place on January 8, 1963.

The position of [redacted] was verified through the "Diplomatic List", dated November, 1963, published by the United States Department of State.
