Dear Sir:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act as amended (5 U.S.C. 552).

I write to request a copy of the CIA letter to the Rockefeller Commission dated June 7, 1975.

To avoid any possible misunderstanding of what is being requested, I make reference to the Final Report of the Select Committee to Study Governmental Operations with Respect to Intelligence Activities, Book V. The Government Printing Office date of publication is April 23, 1976. The reference to the note is made on page 59, footnote 65. My request includes any and all attachments of this letter as transmitted to the Rockefeller Commission by your organization.

As you know, the amended act provides that if some parts of a file are exempt from release that "reasonably segregable" portions shall be provided. I therefore request that, if you determine that some portions of the requested document are exempt, you provide me immediately with a copy of the remainder of the letter. I, of course, reserve my right to appeal any such decisions.

If you determine that some or all of the letter is exempt from release, I would appreciate your advising me as to which exemptions or exemption you believe covers the material which you are not releasing.

My organization is prepared to pay reasonable costs for locating the requested document and reproducing it.

As you know, the amended act permits you to waive or reduce the fees if that "is in the public interest because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the public." I believe that this request plainly fits that category and ask that you waive any fees.

If you have any questions regarding this FOIA request, please telephone me at the above number.

As provided for in the amended act, I will expect to receive a reply within ten (10) working days.

We appreciate the cooperation which we hope we will receive and look forward to future requests.
