SUBJECT: Revolutionary Plan for Latin America

I. OVERVIEW

1. KUBANK is importing a revolutionary organization to further the aims of the United States in its efforts to combat Communism in PERUANIA.

II. INSTRUMENTALITY

2. The Executive Committee of AMIA consists of high-ranking PERUANIAN exiles, politicians and business leaders, all of whom are anti-Communist, some of whom are expected to hold positions in the new government when Cesarini is deposed in PERUANIA. Support is in the form of a subsidy for political and ideological action.

III. PURPOSE

3. AMIA serves as a "front" for KUBANK sponsored political and psychological action, and as a rallying point for alienated political elements in the community of exiles. Funds furnished by KUBANK are for a two-fold purpose, i.e., (a) to support the efforts of AMIA and (b) to pay expenses of recruiting a military strike. KUBANK is the largest contributor in support of this group.

IV. FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND EXPENSES

4. Its present plan is to contribute approximately \$100,000 per month which is to be divided with the members of the group. One member, \$20,500, will be used directly for administrative support of the organization and the other \$79,500 for operational projects and personnel expenses.
