(haul Hernander) a 33 year old Cuban male refugee was first an in our clinic on October 14, 1965 with the history of having emosphalitis at the age of 3, having seizures at the age of 12, boding troated with modication, doing well until 1958 when he was beaton by the Batista police. From that time on he had 4 or 5 cultures a month, fought in the Bay of Pigs, escaped from Cuba, and was treated in the United States at Mercy Hospital.

"His soinures continued and in 1964 removal of a focal epileptic Toom his Right Corobral Hemiophere was done in Kemphis. Since that time has been on Dilantin, Phenobarbital, and Myseline, took modications irregularly and had frequent seizures. Since Chat time he has been repeatedly seen in clinic, and we have tried to bring his scieures under control by getting him to take his mudicusion regularly. At the present time we are still trying to regulate his mediention. He has 2 to 3 seigures per month.
