WORLD BRIEF

(BOGUS IN BLASTS. REMAINING INFO RELEASEABLE TO LIAISON)

1. COMINT: LABOR AGITATION HAS DIED DOWN AT LEAST TEMPORARILY IN FACE OF STRONG ACTION AGAINST UNICE LEADERS BY THE MAN "EMERGENCY COMMITTEE" WHICH COULD SOON TURN INTO A POLITICAL GROUP. THIS GROUP IS PREPARED TO ENDURE AS LONG AS THE GOVERNMENT IS CLOSED. IT IS KNOWN THAT MEMBERS OF THIS COMMITTEE DO NOT CONCERN THEMSELVES WITH THE SITUATION AND IT APPEARS THAT HE IS ENTITLED MARSHALY IGNORED AT THE MOMENT, AT LEAST AS FAR AS DOMESTIC AFFAIRS ARE CONCERNED. HOWEVER, MINISTER ARMY IS THE TOP MAN OF THIS COMMITTEE, BUT IF ARMY WERE INVOLVED, A BIG STRUGGLE FOR LEADERSHIP ALMOST CERTAINLY WOULD FOLLOW.

SERIOUS CLASH BETWEEN BASICALLY ANTIFASCIST NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN
SECTIONS OF THE COUNTRY. COMMUNIST INFLUENCE OVER MACA IS THEREFORE
BEING RESISTED IN THE GOVERNMENT. EVEN THOUGH LABOR UNION LEADERS
HAD EARLIER FORCED HIM OUT. THE CAUTIATION OF THE NEW LEADERSHIP

AND SARAWAK PARTS SICK OF BEING USED IN THIS CONTEXT AND LARGER
CLASHES SEEM LIKELY ALONG THE BORDER. IN SINGAPORE, HARDEST MALAYSIAN

AMONG THE MILITARY OVERNMENTS POLICY TOWARD NORTH VIETNAM ARE INDICATIVE OF CONTINUING UNREST. THE REGIME EVIDENTLY CONTINUES TO BRACE ITSELF FOR A REDUCTION OF US AID. VIET CONG ACTIVITY DURING THE PAST TWO WEEKS HAS INCREASED SLIGHTLY BUT CASUALTIES ON BOTH SIDES -- AND GOVERNMENT WEAPONS LOSSES -- ROSE SHARPLY AS A RESULT OF THE BATTLE AT LOC NAM IN THE DELTA ON 19 OCT. //

3. ALGERIA-MOROCCO: THE CEASE-FIRE AGREEMENT REACHED AT BAMAKO RESOLVES NO BASIC PROBLEMS BEHIND THE BORDER DISPUTE ALTHOUGH TEMPORARILY IT MAY SAVE FACE FOR BOTH BEN KHLA AND KING HASSAN. THE AGREEMENT, WHICH BECOMES EFFECTIVE 2 NOVEMBER, IS ALREADY SUBJECT TO DIFFERENT INTERPRETATIONS, SINCE MOROCCO STILL INSISTS ON SPECIFIC NEGOTIATION OF THIS PARTICULAR BORDER PROBLEM WHILE THE ALGERIANS WANT THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY TO DISCUSS ONLY GENERALITIES AND PRINCIPLES. THE CAU PREVIOUSLY PROOUNCED ITSELF IN FAVOR OF ESTABLISHED BOUNDARIES AS DRAWN BY THE EX-COLONIAL POWERS. BOTH SIDES MEANWHILE WILL CONTINUE TO LOOK FOR FOREIGN MILITARY ASSISTANCE -- ESPECIALLY FROM RUSSIA AND THE WEST. ALGERIA FROM EGYPT, CUBA, AND THE USSR -- AND EACH WILL REMAIN BASICALLY SUSPICIOUS AND HOSTILE TOWARD THE OTHER'S PRESUMED OBJECTIVES.

6. FRANCE: THE NATIONWIDE 24-HOUR RAIL STRIKE ON 23 OCTOBER WAS A MAJOR PART OF THE TRADE UNIONS' EFFORTS TO PRESS THE GOVERNMENT TO LIBERALIZE ITS WAGE POLICY. THE GOVERNMENT HAS RAISED COST-OF-LIVING INCREMENT FROM THREE TO FOUR PERCENT THIS YEAR BUT LABOR IS ERGATIVE AND THE HIGHLY-HERALDED STABILIZATION PLAN IS IN JEOPARDY. THE CURRENT UNREST IS GROWING IN NATIONALIZED ENTERPRISES--I.E. ALONG RAILWAY AND AIRLINES COMPANIES AND CIVIL SERVANTS. (CONT)

7. BRAZIL: NEW LABOR TROUBLES IN BRAZIL KILLED THE RELATIVELY PEACEFUL PERIOD FOLLOWING PRESIDENT COUILLAT'S SHORT-LIVED TRY TO ESTABLISH A STATE OF EMERGENCY OCT. 1. THE POTENTIALLY CRITICAL SITUATION IN SAO PAULO RAISES POSSIBILITY OF SHOWDOWN BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND ANTI-COUILLAT FORCES. THE LATEST REPORTS ESTIMATE 30 PERCENT OF SAO PAULOS INDUSTRIAL WORKERS ARE ON STRIKE AND SYNPATETIC STRIKES HAVE BROKEN OUT ELSEWHERE.

8. LUCAS: THE VATICAN IS LIKELY TO RECEIVE A CONSIDERABLY OPTIMISTIC REVIEW OF PROSPECTS FOR A MEDIUM DIVIDED BY CONTROVERSY OVER LEONARDO BRUNELLA'S CATHOLIC CHURCH STATE WHICH FORMER SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE HOLY SEE HAS BEEN ACTING IN HAVANA SINCE 1961. (END) 11:00, BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS

BELIEVES HIS EFFORTS TO PROMOTE MORE COOPERATIVE CHURCH-STATE RELATIONS COULD BE SUCCESSFUL AND THERE IS NO REASON WHY THE CHURCH CANNOT FULFILL MORE EFFECTIVE RELIGIOUS MISSION IN CUBA. HE SEEKS AS SO STUMBLING BLOCK THE INRECONCILABILITY OF THE CHURCH'S LONGER RANGE GOALS AND THE REGIME'S IDEOLOGY.

9. ITALY: DIFFICULT NEGOTIATIONS ON CABINET POSTS AND ON A LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM ARE IN PROSPECT AS SOCIALISTS (PSI) AND CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATS (CD) BEGIN TO FORM A CENTER-LEFT COALITION. OPPONENTS OF SUCH AN ALLIANCE HAVE A WIDE RANGE OF TACTICS AVAILABLE TO TRY TO SLOW IT DOWN. SOCIALIST PIPPO MATTIOLI SECRETARY PRIVATELY IS ALLEGED BY RICCARDO LOMBARDO'S CONTROL OF 10 OF THE 500+ PARTIES 59 SEATS ON PSI'S NEWLY-ELECTED 101-MAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE. THIS FEELS SOCIALIST COMMITTEE RESOLUTIONS INCLUDE FOREIGN POLICY RESERVATIONS AT WHICH CD OPPOSITION MAY BALK. (CONT.)

10. DENMARK: PRIME MINISTER HEADS SOCIALIST-RADICAL-LIBERAL COALITION GOVERNMENT--A GRIMMALLY ELIMINATE POLITICAL COUPING--MAY BE FORCED TO CALL EARLY ELECTIONS. THE GOVERNMENT HAS DEFEATED A SERIES OF ED-COMMITTEE ELECTIONS IN RECENT WEEKS BUT ITS MARGIN OF

LEADERS FEAR THE DISRUPTIVE EFFECTS OF A FORMAL CONDEMNATION OF THE CHINESE BOTH IN SOME FOREIGN COMMUNIST PARTIES AND IN THE MOVEMENT AS A WHOLE WOULD OUTWEIGH ANY ADVANTAGES MOSCOW MIGHT DERIVE FROM SUCH A CONFERENCE. (CONT)

13. COMMUNIST CHINA: BEIJING'S ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE IN PAST YEARS HAS BEEN EXTENDED PRIMARILY IN ASIA IS NOW OPENING INCREASED AID ELSEWHERE. SO FAR THIS YEAR ALL OF CHINA'S OFFERS TOTALING \$90 MILLION HAVE BEEN EXTENDED TO MIDDLE EASTERN AND AFRICAN COUNTRIES -- ALGERIA, SYRIA AND THE SOMALI REPUBLIC. SOME OF THESE AS WELL AS EARLIER AID OFFERS TO OTHER COUNTRIES MAY HAVE BEEN MOTIVATED BY DESIRE TO MAINTAIN CHINESE "PRESENCE" IN THE FACE OF SOVIET AID OR TO EXPLOIT WHAT THE CHINESE BELIEVE TO BE FAVORABLE LOCAL CONDITIONS.
