CARRILLO stated his group, "Montecristi", was responsible for attack on the Cuban navy patrol boat 5/13/62 off coast of Cuba. MM-492-S advised that on morning of 5/16/62 Cuban govt.-controlled radio station "Progreso", Havana, accused the U.S., President JOHN F. KENNEDY, and CIA of the outward attack on the Cuban naval patrol boat and referred to admittance of the act by CARRILLO. Broadcast said Cuban Govt. has proof now that CARRILLO acted in service of CIA and the "Yankee Imperialists" (U.S.) and that the boat was located on the coast of Fla.

MM-492-S advised on 5/15/62 that RAUL CASTRO, Minister of Defense of the Socialist Revolutionary Govt. of Cuba, spoke on Cuban nation-wide radio broadcast from Cemetery of Havana during evening 5/14/62 at funeral services for those killed aboard the patrol boat on 5/13/62. He denounced the U.S. and CIA for having provoked the incident which resulted in death of 3 Cubans and wounding of 5, all members of the Cuban Navy.

On 5/15/62, WILLIAM MacCLAIRE, CIA, Covert, Miami, confidentially advised this office that the attack on the Cuban Naval patrol boat was made by a boat in which CIA has operational interest. Stated the boat involved in the incident was due to return to Fla. on 5/16/62. MacCLAIRE did not possess specific details concerning this matter.
