A confidential source abroad, who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished the following information on 10/14/59.

JOHN PITTMAN and his wife and children registered at the flotel Gallic, 14 rue de l'Arcade, Faris, on 9/24/59. They departed on the evening of 9/30/59 for London. They returned from London on 10/4/59 and returned to the Hotel Gallic. They left Paris finally on 10/6/59 by air for Koscow.

The Soviet diplomat IOURI ZOUEV, an Attache of the Soviet Imbassy, Paris, personally handled the visa applications for PITEMAN and his family and delivered to PITEMAN the visas necessary to enable them to travel to Moscow. (C)

During his visit to Paris, PITTMAN received a visitor, an American negro by the name of ELLINGTON, whose exact identity is unknown. He also telephoned a French Cormunist newspaper reporter MARCEL PREFICEILLE. (C.)
