

THE TONE OF THE QUESTIONS ASKED AND MATERIAL COVERED BY THE NEWSMAN DURING HIS 30 MARCH INTERVIEW WITH CUBAN EMBASSY OFFICIALS ROBERTO RQUEZ AND PEDRONG OM E Z, INDICATED TO THE CUBANS THAT THE JOURNALIST INTENDS TO WRITE AN ARTICLE TYING THE VENEZUELAN GOVERNMENT TO THE CUBAN EXILE MOVEMENT AND THE CUBANA BOMBING. THE CUBAN EMBASSY ADMITTED THAT MARQUEZ AND GOMEZ HAD BEEN 2. IN ERROR IN MEETING WITH THE NEWSMAN, BUT INSISTED THAT THEY HAD MADE NO COMMENTS WHICH COULD BE CONSTRUED AS BEING DETRIMENTAL TO THE VENEZUELAN GOVERNMENT OR CRITICAL OF VENEZUELAN HANDLING OF THE CUBANA CASE. HOWEVER, THE CUBANS WARNED THAT IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE NEWSMAN MIGHT CLAIM THAT HE HAD DISCUSSED HIS INFORMATION WITH THE CUBAN EMBASSY IN CARACAS. THE EMBASSY, THEREFORE, WANTED IT CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THAT CUBAN OFFICIALS HAD NOT PROVIDED THE NEWSMAN WITH ANY COMMENTS OR MATERIAL WHICH MIGHT APPEAR IN THE NEWSMAN'S FUTURE ARTICLES.
