This will confirm information furnished on  
May 7, 1960, by Special Agent L. M. Linton of this Bureau to  
Mr. Louis R. Hage of the Department of State; Mr. Mario T.  
Noto of the Immigration and Naturalization Service; and  
Mr. Chester A. Emerick of the Bureau of Customs, and by  
Special Agent R. H. Haynes to Mr. R. Singer of Central  
Intelligence Agency; Commander J. L. Neff of the Office of Naval  
Intelligence; Colonel Eugene Cox, Assistant Chief of Staff for  
Intelligence, Department of the Army; Major J. P. Ford of the  
Office of Special Investigations, Department of the Air Force;  
and Technical Sergeant Joseph Hemphill, of the Joint Staff.

On May 5, 1960, an informant of this Bureau who has  
furnished reliable information in the past advised that an  
unidentified woman contacted Abelardo Blanco, Cuban Consul General,  
Miami, Florida, and informed him that a group of one hundred men  
was being trained in shooting by Pedro Luis Diaz Lanz, former  
chief of Cuban Revolutionary Air Force, and that this woman's  
son is a member of the group. According to the informant, this  
woman further advised Blanco that the group was scheduled to  
depart for Cuba on May 9, 1960.

On May 6, 1960, Mr. Gene Chaput, U. S. Border Patrol,  
Miami, Florida, advised the Miami Office of this Bureau that a  
source of the Border Patrol had related he had gone to the  
residence of Frank Anthony Sturgis on the evening of May 5, 1960,  
and was issued a military uniform and boots. According to this  
source, twenty-eight individuals were scheduled to participate in
