ReMMtel 3/21/68 captioned "SOBOM" which dealt with report received from CIA, Miami, under Caption of "Poder Cuban (Cuban Power)." You determined from CIA that the source of the data contained in the report was Oscar Angulo Reyes, a Cuban radio announcer of operational (5) interest to CIA. Also reMMtel 3/23/68 captioned "Unsub; Attempted Bombing of Chilean Consulate, Miami, Fla., March Twelve, Nineteen sixty-eight, Bombing Matter" which reported results of interview with Angulo. You indicated you felt that Angulo may have fabricated information contained in the report since some of it was incorrect.

Attached for each recipient is copy of CIAlet 3/26/68 captioned "Cuban Power (Poder Cubano)." With reference to the Manuel Perez mentioned on page three, CIA on 3/25/68 asked that we withhold any contemplated contact with him. CIA indicated it might have additional information which would facilitate a productive contact. This request should be adhered to at this time and as soon as additional data is provided by CIA you will be advise

Miami specifically advise whether the attached CIA report contains the same information as the one referred to in the referenced teletypes. Miami also submit its comments, observations and recommendations with respect to the information contained in the attached report and any action which should be taken with respect to the information contained therein, not only by the Miami Office but also by any of the other recipients. Set out appropriate leads where warranted. Mandle promptly.

CIA, Miami, on 21/68 furnished report concerning captioned anti-Castro group. In part report stated Mector CorniNot Llano either placed bomb at Soviet Embassy or made it. Miami noted CorniNot reportedly was in Miami at time of bombing and does not believe him to be involved. Report also identified a number of alleged members of Cuban Power cells. Miami believed the report is complation of unverified rumors and determined from CIA that the source was the above-mentioned Oscar Angulo Reyes. (5)

Angulo was interviewed 3/23/68 and in essence claimed he had overheard a conversation between several Cubans, one of whom was a woman identified as Irmina Bousa. Miami has determined, however, that Bousa was in hospital having baby at the time and could not possibly have been involved in the conversation. Miami feels Angulo may have fabricated the story of the conversation he overheard and that his report to CIA was thereafter further edited by CIA prior/being furnished to the Miami Office.

From a comparison of the report mentioned in the referenced teletypes, it would appear that it is identical (with the 3/26/68 CIA report.
