Mr. Robert Hurwitz who is the First Assistant to Sterling Cottrell, head of the so-called Cottrell Committee, telephoned. He advised that at the White House meeting today concerning Cuban matters, it was decided that full information concerning any British angle should be made available to British representatives in the United States. To that end the State Department is conferring with the British ambassador today to insure complete cooperation from the British.

Hurwitz stated that the two agencies which would be gathering information, indicating a possible use of British territory in connection with the anti-Castro activities, would be CIA and the FBI. He had already contacted CIA and had learned that agency maintains [] and would disseminate to the embassy representatives all pertinent information. Hurwitz asked if the FBI would likewise.

I told him that the FBI did maintain close liaison with British Intelligence officials and regularly disseminated to them pertinent information which we developed of interest to that country. Hurwitz said this would be an excellent arrangement; that the State Department didn't want to interfere with any established relations and this would enable him to assure the White House that the President's desire that information be supplied the British is being already carried out.
