He was also a former commander in Brigade 2506. In the Dominican Republic he is contact with Col. JUAN FOLCH, OLIVA is representing three anti-CASTRO groups, a Dominican. namely RECE, 30th of November, and Comandos L. Through Col. FOLCH, OLIVA is attempting to make arrangements to 9-2-6 establish a base in the Dominican Republic for the aforementioned organizations. These organizations will form a military alliance in order to participate in anti-CASTRO activities. July 20, 1966, an attempt was made to contact DAN WAGES, CIA Covert, Miami, to determine whether or not his agency had an operational interest in OLIVA(S) WAGES was on annual leave at the time. However, AUSTIN HORN, Liaison Officer for CIA Covert, Miami, was contacted. Inquiry was made of him as to the status of OLIVA. HORN reported that CIA locally did not have an operational interest in OLIVA, but that inquiry would be made at the Washington level concerning OLIVA. On July 25, 1966, WAGES who had returned from annual leave, telephonically advised that CIA did have an operational interest in OLIVA, and that the latter was in the Dominican Republic, but was scheduled to return to the States within a short period of time. According to WAGES OLIVA was being operated from Washington (S) WAGES was advised of the information developed by the informant concerning anti-CASTRO activities in the Dominican Republic. 205-11722 (RM) 3-Bureau NOT BECORDED

WAGES was requested to check with his Washington headquarters to determine what portion of the information developed by the informant might be used as build-up material SWAGES advised he would immediately contact his headquarters for an answer.
