On 9/30/66, DAN WAGES, CIA covert, Miami, (protect) and WALLY DEL TORO, USAFAD covert, Miami, (protect) advised that the flight described in LHM was not sponsored by either of those agencies, that they had no information concerning this matter but would attempt to ascertain additional information regarding the raid. ~~(S)~~ ~~(C)~~ ~~(U)~~

Miami contacted EUGENE CHAPUT, Assistant Chief, U. S. Border Patrol, and JERRY LATHAM, Specialist, General Operations, FAA, Miami, and both advised that they had received no pertinent information regarding this matter. *ARMY'S INFO IS NOW DECLASSIFIED PER THEIR LETTER DTD 11-13-97 SLD/KSR 1-27-98 (JFK)*

On 10/3/66, WALLACE SHANLEY, U. S. Customs, Miami, was recontacted regarding this matter and stated that he has developed no additional, pertinent information since 9/30/66, but that he will furnish any information to the FBI which he develops as a result of his contacts and sources.
