Subject, a Cuban national, is employed as navigator for Cuban airline which flies between Havana and Gander primarily. Subject reportedly stated he desired to work in opposition to Castro government and would welcome opportunity to do so let was recommended that we disseminate our data to CIA at headquarters level and that CIA be requested to advise if it has facilities for establishing secure contact with subject at Gander and whether CIA desired information concerning possible contact with subject be passed to him prior to any such contact.
