( A source with whom insufficient contact has been had to determine his reliability advised on September 13. 1960, that he had been propositioned by Bladio del Valle, head of the captioned organization, to train members of the organization for an expedition to Cuba. Subsequently, Del Valle reportedly disclosed that he had obtained \$4,000 in assistànce from Francisco Cajigas, à Euban industrialist who is an exile in Miami, Florida, on September 23, 1960, and that additional financial assistance had been obtained from an unknown contributor who 🏂 believed to he Anselmo Allegro, a former Cuban senator.(U): 77 700 REC- 82 On September 20, 1960, Del Valle, accompanied QCT 24 1960 by the above-mentioned informant, voluntarily appeared at our Miami Office. Del Valle claimed his organization had 9,000 men in Havana, Ortente, and Pinar del Rio Province. lie indicated a desire to purticipate in the overthrow of 2 the Castro government but stated he did not intend to violate any United States law in carrying out this desire.(U) On October 7, 1960, the informant advised that COPY Del Valle reportedly claimed he had acquired 10,000 rounds of ammunition, had arms stored in various unknown locations, and had equipped members of his organization with field boots.
