CIA in Mexico then communicated with its Headquarters and with the CIA representative in Miami in order to obtain background information. CIA Headquarters previously had received reports from the Bureau concerning subject. CIA learned through its representative in Miami on December 6, 1960, that the subject was wanted and a summary was cabled to CIA in Mexico. According to Simmons CIA in Miami had WHERE learned about subject's fugitive status, from the Border Patrol of Immigration and Naturalization Service O Simmons stated that subject reportedly was conducting intelligence activities in Mexico on behalf of the Castro government. In his statements to the Cuban intelligence official at the time of the telephone call subject implied that he had gained considerable knowledge concerning the plans of the FRD.
