4. KONG LE CLAIMS PATHET LAO NOT SINCERE IN CEASE-FIRE AGREEMENT

Laotian Neutralist General KONG LE reports the Pathet Lao are moving up artillery and continuing to shell neutralist positions in the Plaine des Jarres (PDJ) despite the recent cease-fire agreement. Sporadic fighting has continued in the PDJ since the 16 November parley between KONG LE and Pathet Lao General SINGAPO. On 21 November, Neutralist Headquarters ordered its forces to continue attacks in the PDJ. (2/RD/LSY/T59-63, 220418Z). ~~(SECRET KIMBO)~~

5. SIHANOUK THANKS PEKING LEADERS FOR THEIR SUPPORT

Prince SIHANOUK, Cambodian Chief of State, expressed the gratitude of his people and government for the support Peking declared the day before. In a 23 November message addressed to MAO TSE TUNG, LIU CHAO CHI and CHOU EN LAI, SIHANOUK observed, among other things, that China had earned the right for Cambodia's gratitude and that other states in a similar situation could depend upon Peking's support.
