He repeated the Indian Government's attachment to the policy of nonalignment despite Chinese aggression, which it had been obliged to stop by force, and pointed out that it is not enough to denounce war, but that it is advisable to find means to prevent it. The only foreign representatives -- despite the efforts of DIWAN CHAMAN LALL, who incidentally had asked me to obtain messages from and Your Excellency and to whom I replied that it is not our tradition to send them to meetings of this type -- are Soviet, Yugoslav, Ceylonese and British, Moreover, Madame NIKOLAEVA, member of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR, brought congratulations only from the nongovernmental organization. Yugoslavia delegated Mr. VILFAN, former ambassador to New Delhi. Mr. GREENWOOD, Chairman of the Labor Party, read a communication from Mr. HAROLD WILSON but made it clear that he was participating
