Shortly after news of the assassination reached Cuba unidentified military units in Oriente Province, possibly hear Guantanamo, were placed on an alert; units in the Eastern Naval District were ordered to be ready to repell aggression; and Foreign Minister ROA instructed Cuban diplomatic missions not to make any statements. And in an unprecedented move, Havana ordered the link to the to stay open all night. Another message to requested complete data on Lyndon JOHNSON, "including his political connections, etc:." The following day, Havana originated a message urging a calm objective analysis of the facts and their possible consequences, stating that both the EISENHOWER and KENNEDY administrations had been guilty of economic aggression tending to cause economic ruin and hunger among the people. Nonetheless, the official Cuban statement issued on the 23rd, expressed "deep sorrow" at the news of the "tragic death" of the President. A message of the same date
