0749	SFCNL
0810	Notified McAulisse in B3 of NSAEUR DET FKFT 220800Z. He will inform Mr Toll when he comes in. Msg in day file.
0830	Called Mr Barry of B105 regarding SHAMROCK item mentioned in 2100 entry of 23 November. He will take up with B14 and report back.
0900	Rec'd ANALIT 40-63 From DIA. Plot Against ROK Gov't. Col Lang apprised, and says that we have absolutely nothing to substantiate the report. <i>This ANALIT subsequently readdressed to USM-48 per B2 request</i>
1045	Called RCI and requested that they send us a cable restating the request contained in entry 1700 of 23 November
1055	Called Mr Noonan of C11 and informed him of extent of NSA operations tomorrow.
1105	NIC Sit Check
1120	Called Mr JM Gallo C122 regarding USM-47 231415Z. He does not think that it will require an answer before Tuesday, but he will check in tomorrow, probably, and will want to see the msg. It is in the day file for Sunday.
1130	Following people have been notified of holiday status tomorrow: <i>MARSTON, Chief</i> Austin, Chief B Group; Conley, Chief of A. Mr Stewart of B1 also notified Zaslow, Swears, and Jenks of B2,3, and 4. C4 and C3 were notified also by Mr Stewart of B1 and provided with B1's requirements for monday. Mr Noonan of C11 was informed of the extent of the effort planned for monday and C13 <i>was</i> told by B1 of their needs. R, M, and S notified by M63.
1155	Hutch Young, Chief B14, called regarding the Shamrock item. (0830 above) He is not too clear what Bradley had in mind, but will check further into it.
1200	Mr Clark of C3 called to find out what NSA plans for monday were.
1205	NIC called and stated Watch Draft report will be drafted in NIC and there will be no need for formal presentation. Any serious developments can be coordinated by telephone.

TIME (L)	EVENT
1207	General Blake called and asked if there had been any confirmation of press report that day of mourning applies to State Department and DOD agencies if heads so decide. He also asked that Mr Kirby be phoned and asked to call him at his home. <u>And that General Davis also be requested to call him upon his return.</u> General Blake also wanted to know what the approximate working strength for tomorrow would be. Told him about the same as a normal week-end with an oversized septimus complement in B1 and a skeleton crew in all the divisions of B2. A group to be about the same as any holiday with a slight increase for purpose of preparing for Watch Committee meeting and USIB.
1210	Mr Kirby called and asked for brief run down and NSA operations for tomorrow. Releayed General Blake's message to him.
1214	Hutch Young reports that the SHAMROCK matter has all been taken care of.
1220	Lou Grant asked that we readdress DIA ANALIT 40-63 to USM-48.
