All the television and radio stations gave full coverage to the assassination of President KENNEDY at noon today in Dallas, Texas immediately after he was shot by an unknown person. The motives which led to the perpetration of this deed are not as yet known.

In accordance with the American constitution Mr. LYNDON JOHNSON will assume the Presidency of the Republic.

The Dean of the diplomatic corps sent a joint telegram of condolence on behalf of the diplomatic corps. We have also sent telegrams of condolence to the new President, the Secretary of State, President KENNEDY's father, wife and brothers.

This event has had a severe reaction among all American, foreign, and UN circles as the television and radio stations have reported.
