



DR. EDWARD GUNN, Chief, Operations Division, Office of Medical Services, has a notation that on 16 August 1960, he received a box of Cuban cigars to be treated with a lethal material. (21). He understood them to be CASTRO's favorite brand. (21). GUNN's notes show that within the next month he contacted (a) Treichler, of TSD, (Sept. 6, 1960) and gave him the box of cigars (21). (Treichler)

recalls "that he did contaminate a full box of 50 cigars with Botulinum Toxin, a virulent poison," (21) which would kill the intended victim upon merely putting it in the mouth. Freichler's notes showed delivery of the box on February 13, 1961, although they do not indicate to whom. (22).
