MAURICE BISHOP, aka JOHN BISHOP, JIM BISHOP, and FNU FIRGAULT. This name is most likely an alias and this NR individual's true name is not known to the Committee. Bishop was working in anti-Castro operations in the early 1960s. He was also allegedly involved in a plot to assassinate Fidel Castro in Chile in 1971 with Antonio Veciana and Luis Posada.


