I have approved a salary increase of \$1,980.00 per year effective April 1, 1978 for Louis Parisi, a staff investigator for the Select Committee.

As Mr. Parisi's basic salary and benefits are paid by the New Jersey State Police, his additional salary from the House is paid in the form of a monthly expense allowance per prior agreement with your staff and the Clerk of the House. This was to avoid Mr. Parisi from earning retirement benefits from both the Federal Government and the State of New Jersey.

Accordingly, Mr. Parisi's monthly expense allowance will increase from \$625.00 to \$790.00 effective April 1, 1978.
