Phillip Geraci, was in Carlos Bringuier's store when LHO came in and offered his Marine manuel.

Subject reiterated his Warren Commission testimony, changed one point--subject states Vance Blalock (whereabouts unknown to date) mentioned that LHO asked Carlos Bringuier if he was a member of the (Cosa Nostra)--subject feels the name asked was Casa Roca, the store operated by Carlos Bringuier. Subject was a C.A.P. cadet for approximately one (1) year--62-63, didn't know David Ferrie, and had little or no contact with senior group headed by Ferrie.
