He advised that she married an individual named FLANNERY, who worked as Program Director for the Columbia Broadcasting System in NYC. They used to live at the Schwab House, NYC, but had moved to somewhere in the Greenwich Village area of NYC . On 5/19/66, former PCI RUDOLPH RASMUSSEN, Superintendent, 525 Park Avenue, NYC, advised SAS DURKIN and DONNELLY that PHYLLISAMC GUIRE was last seen here the previous Monday (5/16/66). On 5/19/66, MURRAY KANE, Theatrical Agent for the McGuire Sisters, 157 West 57th Street, advised SA ANTHONY R. VILLANO that NAOMI FLANNERY was formerly the secretary for the McGuire Sisters. He pointed out she was not PHYLLIS MC GUIRE's personal secretary, but was shared between the three sisters, himself and a bookkeeper. He said at the present time, ANNA DONALD has this position. He advised that PHYLLIS MC GUIRE is presently on a vacation and is expected to return in about one week to NYC, at which time the sisters will rehearse for a few weeks.

On 5/19/66, FRANK/FLANNERY, Columbia Broadcasting System, was telephonically contacted by SA DONNELLY and advised that his wife is NAOMI FLANNERY, who used to work for PHYLLIS MC GUIRE. He was advised the agents wished to interview her and desired his home address. He refused to furnish his home address and stated he will contact his wife and at his convenience will telephonically recontact the agent and advise if he will make his wife available for interview. ()

Shortly thereafter, PCI RANDY BURKE telephonically contacted SA DURKIN and advised the FLANNERYS are presently residing at 171 West 12th Street, NYC.,)

SAS VILLANO and DONNELLY contacted an individual at Apartment 4C, 171 West 12th Street, NYC, who stated she was FRANK FLANNERY's sister, but refused to furnish her name. She stated NAOMI FLANNERY was presently at work and not home. She telephonically contacted NAOMI FLANNERY and advised the agents that NAOMI told her she was going to make an appointment with the agents.

Later on 5/19/66, FRANK FLANNERY telephonically contacted SA DONNELLY and advised that he had been in touch with an attorney and he would make his wife, NAOMI, available for interview if the agent could assure him that this one interview would be the end of this "annoyance". He was advised the agent could give no such assurance and he thom stated, "You'll have to go through the courts". NY 92-793

On 5/20/66, FRANK FLANNERY contacted SA DONNELLY telephonically and advised he would make his wife available for interview that evening. He suggested that the agents meet him and his wife at 12 Vanderbilt Avenue, NYC.
