Prosecutors contemplate subpoenaing other persons who were threatened by ALDERISIO even though those persons refuse to discuss it. The strategy is that the presence of these people around the courtroom would discourage ALDERISIO taking stand in his own defense which would be an advantage to the prosecution.

They will probably subpoena MORRIS LITBERG and from Los Angeles, and probably SEGAL, who was threatened by ALDERISIO in New York City. New York and Los Angeles advised of this as victim might contact that office and prosecutors will probably be in phone contact with these witnesses and might subpoena New York agents who worked on SEGAL matter.

By radiogram dated 10/6/64, Bureau was requested to locate fingerprint card on EGAN's U. S. Air Force enlistment and forward serial number to St. Louis, in order that EGAN's service record might be checked.
