CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANTS

One "T symbol" has been assigned to each CI, PCI or other source required to be concealed, throughout the course of reporting instant investigation. Thus, T-1 or T-21 in early reports is the same individual as T-1 or T-21 in any later report. This system was adopted before the current regulation requiring that informants in each office territory be identified with the name of that office preceding the symbol number. In view of the large number of T informants in this investigation (131) and to avoid confusion in review, it being noted that in each report only a portion of all the informants are mentioned, no change-over has been made and all the informants continue to carry the designation Albany T-1, etc., instead of New York T-10, Los Angeles T-5 and so on.
