On 6/2/67, PCI LAWRENCE JOHN GOBLE entered the Blue Banner Social Club at approximately 2:00 P.M. Surveillances by Bureau Agents determined that none of the prominent members of the "MAGADDINO Family of LCN" were at the Club. GOBLE stayed at the Club until approximately 3:10 P.M. He later advised that during the period he was present at the Club, the "skin" game was not being conducted. He advised that he observed none of the more prominent hoodlums in the Club. Informant said that he will again attend the game on 6/7/67.

Spot surveillances by Bureau Agents during the afternoon of 6/2/67, determined that FRED G. RANDACCIO; PASQUALE A. NATARELLI and other prominent members of the "MAGADDINO Family" were present at a restaurant on the corner of Hampshire and Niagara Streets, Buffalo, N.Y., which they have been frequenting for the past several weeks. It, therefore, appears that the "skin" game was not being conducted on 6/2/67. It is noted that the schedule of this
