A key witness in this case against WAINWRIGHT was DONALD HOWARD MACH of Springfield who testified that he and WAINWRIGHT took clothing from a motor car parked in Johnson County. WAINWRIGHT had previously stated that MACH was "out to get him" and had threatened WAINWRIGHT after he had refused to send MACH \$1,000 in 1961.

ERNEST O. ANDERSON, former President of Teamster Local 541, is to stand trial on 4/3/62 on charges of burglary and grand larceny, in Johnson County Circuit Court, Olathe, Kansas. This charge also stems from his involvement with WAINWRIGHT and concerns theft of furniture from a model home. Charges against WAINWRIGHT on this matter are still outstanding.

PCI SHIRLEY HERRINGOLA advised that she has gotten the impression from JOHN RIMA that the FBI has put so much pressure on the "Clique" lately that everyone in the "Clique" is afraid to engage in illegal activities and that no one seems to be gambling lately.

Miss JEANETTE WORDEN, Blue Springs, Missouri, advised that she has had close association with THOMAS "HIGHWAY" SIMONE, FBI #788974, and would very likely be considered SIMONE's girl friend. She advised, however, that she has not associated in the past several weeks with SIMONE due to a vacation trip she has recently taken and also due to the fact that while on this trip she met an individual she will marry in the near future.
