On January 14, 1958, JOSEPH BRUSCO, 207 Guyasuta Road, Fox Chapel, Pa., was interviewed at his bar at 549 North Homewood Avenue, Pittsburgh. BRUSCO allegedly had furnished information to ANDREW J. SUSCE, former IRS collector, Pittsburgh, regarding the number's activities of JOHN LA ROCCA. BRUSCO advised that the information he had given in the past was now "ancient history" and that at the time he furnished this information he did so only because he was pressured as regards to his own income tax.
