INTELLIGENCE OFFICER, U.S. COAST GUARD, ADVISED THAT ON MARCH 24 LAST THE USCG OBSERVED THE ALISAN AT AN UNNAMED ISLAND LOCATED BETWEEN ANGUILA KEY AND DAMASK KEY IN THE CAY SAL GROUP AND APPROXIMATELY 70 AIR MILES FROM CAIBARIEN, CUBA. EIGHT MEN, SOME CUBAN IN APPEARANCE, WERE OBSERVED ON BOARD THE ALISAN WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 50 FEET LONG AND OBSERVED TO BE EQUIPPED WITH A RADIO AERIAL. THE ALISAN HAD IN TOW A SMALL TENDER AND WHAT APPEARED TO BE A SPEED BOAT ABOUT 20 FEET LONG WITH WINDSHIELD, INBOARD MOTOR AND RADIO EQUIPPED. LETTERS WHICH APPEARED TO BE F-82 WERE OBSERVED ON THE BOW OF THE ALISAN. THIS IS NOT BELIEVED TO BE A US REGISTRATION NUMBER. USCG TOOK ABOUT FOUR AERIAL PHOTOS OF THIS BOAT WHICH SHOW THE EIGHT MEN ON BOARD.

AT 5:20 PM TODAY, REES, CIA, ADVISED HE HAD JUST RECEIVED FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL INFO FROM SOURCE DESCRIBED AS FORMER CUBAN GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE WHO RECEIVED INFO FROM AN INDIVIDUAL IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH ALPHA 66.
