NY T-20 advised that on April 8, 1961, a (First Name Unknown) (FNU) CLAYMAN, 8 Kingsgate Avenue, London N-3, England, communicated with the subject and on April 7, 1961, a G. KAYE, 3 Langland Mans., London NW 3, England, communicated with the subject.

NY T-21, a confidential source abroad, advised on August 11, 1961, that ALEXANDER CLAYMAN and his wife, DORIS THERESA CLAYMAN nee POSER, reside at 8 Kingsgate Avenue, London, N. 3, England. Born London, England July 3, 1921 (S) Mrs. Alexander Clayman (S)

England (S) CLAYMAN was born in London on July 3, 1921, the son of HYMAN CLAYMAN, a tailor. Mrs. CLAYMAN was born August 24, 1924, at Leipzig. Her father, SIGFRIED POSER Germany England was granted British nationality in 1939. ALEXANDER CLAYMAN is managing director of three garment manufacturing firms. NY T-21 informed that one of the directors of one of these firms is BERNARD JOSEPH CLAYMAN. His relationship with ALEXANDER is unknown; however, one BERNARD JOSEPH CLAYMAN in 1948 was a member of the "43 Group", an organization formed by Jews to combat Fascism. Not Loc. (S)

Gordon (G, B) NY T-21 also advised that GORDON HAROLD KAYE, a chartered accountant, was born December 15, 1922, in London, England and resides at 3 Langland Mansions, N. W. 3. London, England He is the son of SIDNEY KAYE formerly ZURECH KOPCHINSKY who was born in Poland. In 1959 GORDON KAY was involved in activities against Sir OSWALD MOSLEY who was at that time running for Parliament. MOSLEY is well known for his Fascist views. A brother of GORDON KAYE, MARSHALL KAYE, England Not Loc in 1948 was a member of the "43 Group" (S)

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
