However, a certain stiffening has characterized the first contact between TIMMONS and Foreign Minister CHALMERS and Deputy Foreign Minister RAYMOND at the Foreign Ministry Building.

The Foreign Ministry's general opinion is that he is the least qualified at the present time and that his presence could be fatal for the resumption of relations.

Please see if he can be recalled before he presents his 64-330 - 217 - 39 credentials.
