Judging from the contents of the attached report, as well as from a thorough study of all the material contained in the files of this office on SUBJECT, it appears probable that SUBJECT is a low level Soviet espionage agent who may be operating with Ilya JAKUBENOV. SUBJECT, a former Soviet Army officer, probably deserted to the Germans and volunteered for the Wehrmacht Army to escape execution. In 1945, he again jumped the fence over to the victors and probably cooperated with the Soviet Repatriation Mission as a low level agent to escape forced repatriation and execution as Wehrmacht officer. Although it previously appeared that SUBJECT had discontinued his information gathering activities due to the departure of Soviet missions, the current report indicates that he was still active late in 1948.

3. It is believed that the derogatory information compiled to date on SUBJECT should suffice to prevent his immigration into the US.

4. Source A for the attached report is Vladimir KAS SHUKAI, whose competence to report information is stated in the report. Source B is Vladimir TULEEV, a close friend of SUBJECT who may be trying to protect his friend by giving a lengthy, but inaccurate report on SUBJECT's past.
